# CBT Community of Practice Terms of Reference

### Purpose:

The CBT Community of Practice provides a forum for community site counsellors who have a shared interest in enhancing their CBT skills to engage in a process of collective learning, collaboration, planning, problem solving and solution sharing.

#### **Functions:**

- 1. To enhance the quality of CBT interventions
- 2. To improve members knowledge base, skill and experience with CBT and remain current with best CBT practices
- 3. To serve as a forum for peer networking, collaboration and consultation
- 4. Members will engage in joint activities and discussions, share information, share resources, share experiences, learn from each other and problem solve together

# Membership:

- Community Site Counsellors who regularly practice CBT
- Social Worker/Senior Counsellor with CBT area of responsibility
- Program Manager

# Accountability:

The affinity group will forward recommendations to the CBT Working Group as indicated.

#### Procedures:

- The manager assigned to the affinity group or designate will call and chair the meeting
- Meetings typically are scheduled monthly from September to June
- Minutes will be taken, distributed to the members, approved at the following meeting, and then posted on the Minutes Conference.
